Community Assembly on Accountability & Governance

- a. Identify issues for discussion or improvement
- b. Appoint participants to the community coordination group which may be members of the Assembly or broader community
 - c. Provide ongoing community input to the coordination group

ICANN Supporting Organizations / Advisory Committees may appoint community members who have expressed an interest to serve as representatives. Each SO and AC may appoint up 7 participants to the Assembly, except the GNSO which may appoint up to 4 for each SG

First meeting virtual, followed by face-to-face meeting at ICANN 51

Community Coordination Group on Accountability & Governance

- a. Categorize and prioritize issues identified by the Assembly
- b. Build solution requirements for issues with input from the Assembly
- c. Issue the final report/recommendations
